and Voting Process*

This year's Homecoming is set for **Saturday, September 19**. All student organizations are encouraged to nominate an individual to be a Homecoming King or Queen Candidate. *Each organization is limited to one nominee (male or female)*. Your nominee must be an undergraduate senior with the appropriate number of credits and an expected graduation date of December 2015, May or August 2016.

Please review this information closely:

- Nominees who have submitted the *2015 Homecoming King/Queen Candidate Nomination form* by the deadline of **Wednesday, September 2** and who meet the required criteria will be named a Homecoming King or Queen Candidate.
- RMU students will participate in a preliminary round of on-line voting on **Wednesday and Thursday, September 9 - 10**. The five King and five Queen Candidates who receive the most votes during the on-line voting will be named as members of the 2015 Homecoming Court.
- The Homecoming Court will be announced on **Friday, September 11**.
- A second round of ballot voting will take place on **September 16 – 17** in the Nicholson Center Rotunda from 11 a.m. – 1 p.m. and 4 – 6 p.m.
- The King and Queen Court Member who receive the most votes during this round of voting will be crowned Homecoming King and Queen on **Saturday, September 19**.
- Members of the Homecoming Court and their escorts must attend the RMU football game on **Saturday, September 19** and participate in the half-time ceremony where the names of the winners will be announced. Court members will also be introduced at the Student Homecoming Dance on **Friday, September 18**.

Completed nomination forms must be submitted to the Office of Student Life by 5 p.m. on Wednesday, September 2. Because of the limited amount of time available to conduct two rounds of voting, nominations received after the published deadline will not be considered.
